Handli	ng Do's and Don'ts:
	ALWAYS handle drives ONE AT A TIME
	ALWAYS handle drives by the SIDES
	ALWAYS be very careful with drives, they are VERY SENSITIVE
	ALWAYS USE A CART to move drives once unpacked
	NEVER STACK drives
	NEVER STAND drives on their sides
	NEVER PLACE anything on top of a hard drive
	NEVER DROP drives, even inches
	NEVER TOUCH drives except on the sides
ESD (ElectroStatic Discharge) Must Have's:	
	ESD WRIST STRAPS or ESD HEEL STRAPS ON CONDUCTIVE FLOORING
	ESD WORK MAT on work area
	ALWAYS CHECK condition of ESD straps daily
ESD Good to Have:	
	ESD AIR IONIZERS (balanced ion generators) to reduce static electric charges
WORKBENCH Must Do's:	
	Keep work area CLEAN and CLEAR of tools and equipment
	NO CELL PHONES near workbench
	NO MAGNETIC BRACELETS
SHIPPING Must Do's:	
	Use only APPROVED HDD SHIPPING BOXES and PROTECTIVE PACKAGING
